New Zealand SLT Surgical voice restoration clinician register – July 2023

This register provides speech-language therapists with a list of Level 3-4 SVR SLTs across the country for both pathway 1 (with a voice prosthesis change) and pathway 2 for level 3 clinicians (without a voice prosthesis change). This list is updated in July and December each year. Sign off at each level is managed according to sign off level (see NZSTA SVR Competency Framework). For the NZSTA registry, evidence must be sighted by the NZSTA.

Level 3: pathway two without voice prosthesis change, requires level 1 and level 2 to be completed as a prerequisite

SLT will be able to trouble shoot and hypothesise regarding communication and swallowing difficulties with a laryngectomy population and be able to advise on other aspects of laryngectomy management, such as baseplate and heat moisture exchange (HME) use. Are not able to provide supervision and sign off.
