

Clinical Field Educator's Service Award

This award is provided in partnership with the Clinical Directors from the three NZSTA accredited universities together with the NZSTA.

Value:

The award is valued at \$900

Award Process:

The clinical directors from the NZSTA accredited universities will identify a potential award winner. They will submit, in writing, the name of the person or people meeting the award criteria to the Executive Council by February 1st each year. Evidence of how the nominee meets the criteria will be required. The winner(s) of the Clinical Field Educator's Service Award will be endorsed by the NZSTA Executive Council and announced at the NZSTA AGM each year.

Criteria:

1. Member of the NZSTA
2. Demonstrates professional and ethical standards in their practice
3. Offers frequent placements to at least two NZSTA-accredited universities within an 18 months period
4. Demonstrates innovation and initiative in supervision practices
5. Provides high quality clinical education in the workplace
6. Provides constructive, appropriate and timely feedback regarding the students' development to the Clinical Directors
